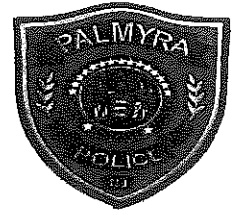

Parents of CSS Students,

Last fall the Borough awarded a road improvement contract for the replacement of the roadway and some drainage lines for West Charles Street. This project was to start last November, but was postponed due to the activity at the school and was scheduled to start on June 23rd. At the request of our engineers the project will start on Monday June 16th. We do realize that this is the last week of school; however there is a need to move as fast as possible so that the contractor is hopefully able to complete the project prior to the start of the new school year. The Police Department and our Municipal Engineers will be working with the contractor to minimize the effect to students walking and being driven to school.

Starting Monday June 16th West Charles Street will be closed to vehicular traffic from Cinnaminson Ave to Walnut Street. Parents will still be able to access the school from the 900 Block of Walnut Street via East Henry Street or West Charles Street from Park Ave. We will be making sure that the sidewalk on one side of West Charles Street in the construction zone is open to pedestrian traffic so that students and parents can safely walk to and from the school. ***Two Police Officers will be assigned to the construction zone to ensure the safety of those traveling to the school.***

As always we ask that parents be mindful of our vehicular and pedestrian laws when taking your children to school. We ask that you only cross at crosswalks and not from the middle of the roadway. Also when dropping children off at the school from a car that you safely pull to the curb and not allow them to exit the car from the travel lane.
