3 Boxes of Tissues

1 Roll of Paper Towels (optional)

1 Container of Lysol wipes (or similar brand)

3 Jumbo or Extra-Large Book Covers (Book Sox)

Daily snack for morning working-snack time (optional)

Summer Math packet and Reading work

**** Please label all supplies at home before you bring them in.**

A book is **required** at ALL times for silent reading. On the 1st day of school bring in a 4th grade appropriate chapter book.
