Kindergarten and Grades 1 & 2 are encouraged to go home for lunch so that they might return in their costumes prepared to walk in the Halloween Parade. **A note from the parent/guardian must be sent in to the teacher that morning.** The kindergarten, first and second grade students who will be going home for lunch and costume change, and who have provided a note will be dismissed at 12:15 through their regular dismissal door. Students are to return by 1:00 through the main entrance door at the front of the building.

Parents and students are reminded of the following in regard to costumes:

- All costumes must be modest and in good taste
 - No clowns

 - No blood
 - No obscenities or derogatory references
 - No political costumes
- Students should be dressed appropriately for the weather
- All costumes should be simple and easy for the students to do themselves, with little assistance. There is no time or assistance available for elaborate make-up or dressing.

No students are to wear their costume to school for 8:15 AM entrance.
